What is a "CDDO"?

A CDDO is a Community Developmental Disability Organization. CDDO's were established as part of the DD Reform Act. A CDDO contracts with the State of Kansas to ensure that services for individuals with mental retardation and developmental disabilities are available locally. In order to do this, CDDO's affiliate with Community Service Providers (CSP's) to ensure a wide range of services and supports are available to all eligible individuals.

What does a CDDO do?

- Acts as the single point of entry for application and information for persons served and their families.
- Determines eligibility for services, supports and funding.
- Affiliates with Community Service Providers of DD services and offers choice
- Reviews requests for services and funding
- Manages local, state and federal funding
- Provides quality assurance for individuals receiving services and supports
- Advocates for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD)

Application Process for ID/DD Eligibility

INTAKE APPOINTMENT

Contact the CDDO of Butler County to schedule an intake appointment at 316-322-8777.

Information on what is required to initiate services, what services are available and eligibility requirements will be provided at the meeting.

APPLICATION FOLLOW THROUGH

The following information will be required in order to process eligibility for ID/DD Services in Butler County:

- I/DD Application
- Medical Examination/Physical from Doctor
- Psychological Evaluation (age 7 & up)
- Developmental Checklist (age 6 & under)
- Copy of Social Security Card
- Copy of government issued ID (if applicable)
- Copy of Medical/Insurance Card
- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Copy of Guardianship Paperwork (if applicable)
- Copy of most recent IEP (Individualized Education Plan)

ELIGIBILITY DETERMINATION

Eligibility for I/DD services will be determined within 5 business days of the CDDO receiving all required information. The CDDO of Butler County determines eligibility according to the DD Reform Act guidelines.

All applicants will be notified via mail of the determination of eligibility for services.

If an applicant is determined eligible, a secondary appointment with the CDDO of Butler County will be necessary to complete the BASIS Assessment required to enter into services. This assessment must be completed within 10 business days and may take up to one hour to complete.

If an applicant is determined not eligible, referrals to other community service providers are made.

Children under the age of 7 will only receive a temporary determination of eligibility for services. At the age of 7, a Psychological Evaluation will need to be completed to determine continued eligibility for services.

The CDDO of Butler County reserves the right to review eligibility on any person served at anytime.

If an applicant is eligible for Case Management Services, a choice form will be completed at the time of the BASIS Assessment and the file will be referred out to the Case Management agency within 5 business days.
